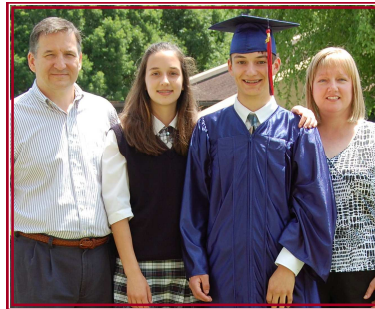
Authentically Catholic

Our students are preparing now for a challenging college preparatory high school program that will take them to college. Prince of Peace is dedicated to providing students

with a strong foundation of grammar and writing skills, algebra, foreign language, science, history and geography, and the arts.

Again this year, half of our 7th grade students qualified as 2010-2011 Duke University TIP Scholars as a result of their academic achievement.
